Kristine Gebbie

Dr. Kristine Gebbie serves as Principal Investigator, overseeing all aspects of the national training strategy with the Office of Assistant Secretary for Preparedness and Response (ASPR). The Director of Health Policy, Columbia University School of Nursing, she brings three key areas of expertise to the project. First, she has experience in managing projects with multiple contributors from fifteen years as a successful state health director, including work with governor's cabinets on emergency preparedness. Second, Dr. Gebbie has extensive experience in professional and continuing education, including satellite broadcast and web-cast training as well as the development of stand-alone web-based training units. Third, Dr. Gebbie is the principal investigator in the development of core emergency preparedness competencies for public health workers, bioterrorism and emergency readiness competencies for public health workers, core emergency preparedness competencies for hospital workers, and emergency preparedness competencies for clinicians in initial assessment and decision-making roles.
